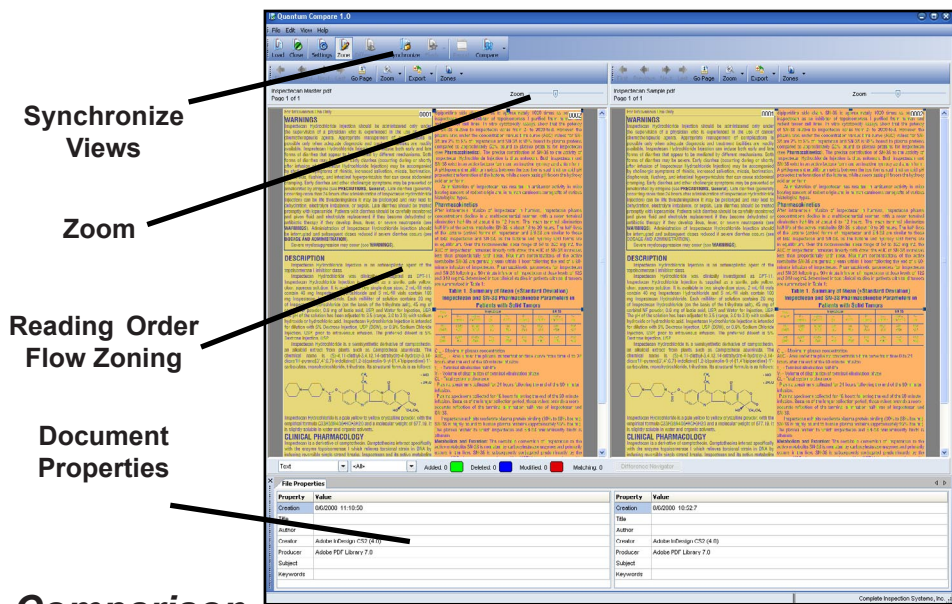
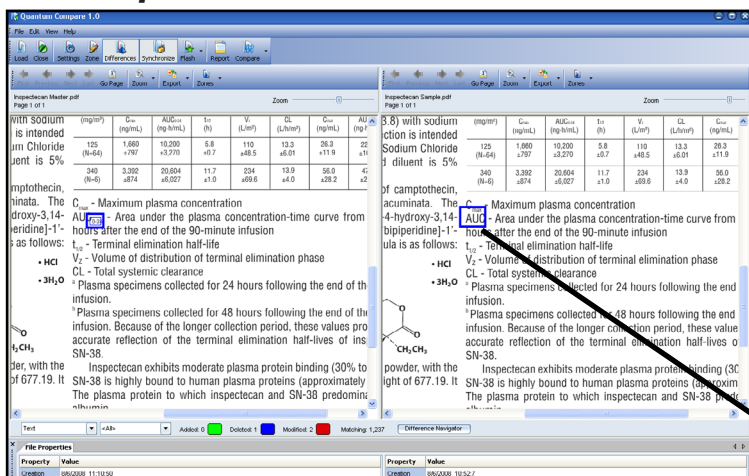


1. Set Comparison Parameters



Quantum Compare™ is a user friendly document comparison system for any organization that demands 100% accuracy in their product information, packaging, manuals and labels - or any other printed materials where accuracy is absolutely essential. Quantum Compare™ is unicode-based, reads PDFs created from any program, and can distill PDF files for comparison from a number of common formats. The most advanced text comparison software on the market today, Quantum Compare™ analyzes the underlying data of each character, rather than its shape or appearance - it cannot make an error, and neither can you. To begin a comparison, the user creates zones, to ensure the text is read by the computer in the same order as a human being.

2. Comparison



Next, the operator executes the comparison. The computer will compile the words present in the two files and compare their underlying data values. The system will then report back the results to the operator. In the image to the left, a subscripted "0-24" was left out after the words "AUC" - the system reports the change as a deleted word. A word present in the master file was left out of the sample and hence the word is deleted. The change is highlighted in the document in the original context. The difference is also listed in the Difference Navigator along with the type of difference, and in the same order the errors would be spotted reading the document. Use Quantum Compare™ to check your documents after each revision, to verify only intentional changes were made.

3. Analysis

The difference navigator assists the operator in discovering the errors in the document. What was changed? What is the precise nature of the change? The Difference Navigator will give details about how and where the change occurred, and shows the original word alongside the changed word for the operator to examine.
